

## Seventh Street Extension

**BMD Constructions successfully opened the Seventh Street extension project at Sydney's Domestic Airport to the public prior to Christmas 2015.**

### Overview

Seventh Street is located off Qantas Drive at the Sydney Domestic Airport, approximately half an hour out of Sydney's CBD. BMD Constructions was contracted to extend Seventh Street to provide a five lane exit from the Sydney Airport Domestic Precinct onto Qantas Drive which is the first stage of the Major Development Plan to improve access in and around Terminal 2 and Terminal 3 at Sydney Airport.

### Project scope

The scope of works included:

- demolition of hangars, existing pavement and fencing
- relocation of services
- installation of stormwater and sewer
- installation of Telstra and Jemena
- construction of new roadway, traffic lights, pedestrian/cycleway, security boom gates and new rental car exists
- remediation
- general fencing
- landscaping.

### Outcomes

BMD delivered the project on time and budget, were Lost Time Incident (LTI) free and had zero Medical Treatment Injuries (MTI) on site.

The project began slowly due to previously unknown contamination issues however, BMD were able to accelerate the program to ensure works were still completed within the seven month timeframe.

While the extension is open to traffic, the project team will remain on site to deliver further works including an additional left turn lane on Seventh Street.

The team are now looking forward to their next package of works at the Sydney Domestic Terminal which involves further road improvements around the terminal.
