

Parkes to Narromine Inland Rail Project



EMPLOYMENT - EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

The Parkes to Narromine (P2N) Project (**Project**) is one of 13 projects that comprise the Inland Rail Programme (**Programme**). It is one of seven in NSW, and is approximately 103.708 km long (98.408 km brownfield, 5.3 km greenfield, 3 crossing loops suitable for 1.8 km long trains). The Project is the first project within the Programme to be brought to market, and represents a significant first step in ARTC delivering the Programme.

P2N is predominantly a brownfield site on the existing Goobang Junction to Narromine line within the ARTC network. The P2N section also includes the North-West connection (5.3 km of greenfield connection, including a fork at Southern junction). The line is a single bi-directional track, running a variety of freight and grain. The works consist of approximately 100km of upgraded brownfield track and associated facilities, and is generally located in the existing Rail Corridor between the towns of Parkes and Narromine, via Peak Hill. A new connection to the Broken Hill line is also proposed outside the existing Rail Corridor at the southern end of the Project near Parkes.

The key features of the Project involve:

- Upgrading the track, track formation and culverts within the existing Rail Corridor for a distance of approximately 100km including signal upgrade between Parkes and Narromine
- Providing three new crossing loops within the existing Rail Corridor at the nominated locations
- Providing a 5.3 km long rail connection between Inland Rail and the Broken Hill line to the west of Parkes
